FROM FATHER JOHN

On February 7 through February 9, St. Richard Church will be welcoming two visiting priests from New Orleans who will be providing us with a 'mini-mission' in preparation for the Lenten Season. Fr. Stephen Ellis and Fr. Gregory Heslip will be with us those three days to offer mornings and evenings of reflection, as well as guided prayer, opportunities for confession, and personal consultations. I pray all of you will consider taking advantage of their ministries while they are here.

Frs. Ellis and Heslip are priests from the Legion of Christ, a Catholic institute that is affiliated with the apostolic movement Regnum Christi. Both of them serve as chaplains for the Regnum Christi Movement in Mississippi and Louisiana, and they are stationed out of New Orleans. Both of these priests bring several years of experience in ministry, and I am excited to host them.

As we move from the Christmas season and prepare to enter into the season of Lent, it is a good time to ask ourselves a few questions. Are we growing in our prayer lives as we should? Am I confessing the same old group of sins over and over while staying stalled in my path to holiness? Are we finding it difficult to forgive others (and maybe even ourselves) if we ourselves have been forgiven by God our Father? These are questions that all of us struggle with, and these will be questions that will be addressed during our time with Frs. Ellis and Heslip.

Please mark your calendars for those days and check the bulletin in the coming weeks for the specific times and locations of the sessions. I know it will be a wonderful opportunity for our parish to get 'jump-started' for the season of Lent.
