FROM FATHER JOHN

In last weekend's gospel, Jesus instructed His disciples to be mindful about the 'root' causes of sinfulness, be it anger or lust or any of the other deadly sins. In my homily, I spoke about how we need to be very careful about what information and which influences we let into our minds and hearts, as these things bear fruit in our individual behaviors, be it virtuous or vicious.

Many of you told me how helpful the analogy of the "2 Dogs Fighting" was. To refresh your memories, I mentioned how the interior life of any individual is an ongoing battle between good and evil. An old Indian proverb described this battle as '2 Dogs Fighting,' and the dog who wins is 'the one you feed.' Sadly, we Americans today feed our souls with too much information and too many influences that nourish the 'evil dog.' We watch too much trashy television, we view too much garbage on the internet, we listen to and speak too much gossip with our neighbors. And then we wonder why our lives seem to unexpectedly become beset with temptation and sinfulness. Hey, garbage in, garbage out! This should come as no surprise.

Traditional Catholicism teaches us that the root causes of sinfulness are the '7 Deadly Sins' or the 'Deadly Vices.' These are Pride, Greed, Lust, Envy, Gluttony, Anger and Sloth. These seven deadly dispositions, if left unchecked to take root and grow in our hearts, will sooner or later bear bad fruit in sinful behavior such as murder, adultery, theft, etc. Therefore, start today to recognize if and when these vices enter your hearts through the stuff you watch, hear or experience. Failure to recognize and stop them will inevitably lead you to sin. Again, garbage in, garbage out! Believe that, and fight against that each day.
