FROM FATHER JOHN

Jhis Wednesday begins the sacred season of Lent. For 40 days, we Catholics are called to intensify our prayer and other spiritual practices in order to prepare ourselves to more worthily celebrate the Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. This tradition of Lent is an ancient one in our Church, and Ash Wednesday is the busiest day of our Church year in regards to Mass attendance (even more than both Christmas and Easter).

This year in the United States we find ourselves to be a pretty divided people. Politically, economically, and culturally we Americans find ourselves increasingly polarized. It seems like we are having a more difficult time getting along with one another. Our tone and language is increasingly becoming more coarse, confrontational and violence-provoking. If there is ever a group of people who need 'a Lent,' it is us Americans.

Lent is a time of self-denial, of sacrifice, of self-discipline that helps us to 1) experience a bit more of the sacrifice Christ made for us 2000 years ago, and 2) purposely train ourselves for the inevitable sacrifices our faith will demand of us. In light of this, I recommend that this year we make some sacrifices regarding how we relate to and speak with others, especially those we may disagree with. If someone says something about politics or anything else that makes you angry, 'turn the other cheek' and offer your frustration up 'for the poor souls in purgatory!' If someone frowns and insults you, offer them a smile and a "God bless you." To quote a wise, well-known non-Catholic named Gahndi, "Be the change you want to see in the world."

I pray you all have a prayerful and productive season of Lent. Please check the bulletin, our website and our Facebook page to find out about the various Lenten activities of St. Richard Church. Let's prepare well to once again celebrate the Resurrection of our Lord.

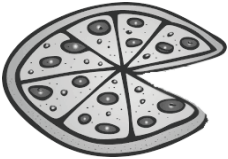
