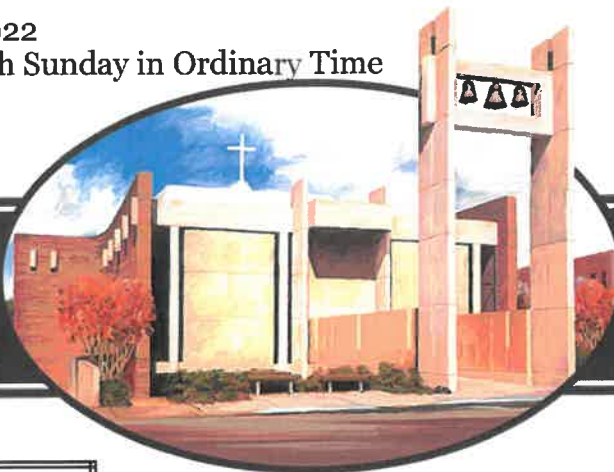

## Knights of Columbus Silver Rose:

Each year, from early March through mid-December, Silver Roses are distributed by Knights of Columbus councils along routes from Canada to Mexico. Every stop the Silver Rose makes throughout the pilgrimage is a rosary-centered occasion for Knights, parishioners, and community members to pray for respect for life, for the spiritual renewal of each nation, and for the protection of the unborn and support of mothers exemplified by the image of Our Lady of Guadalupe. **The Silver Rose will be at St. Richard on October 11<sup>th</sup> from 2:00pm until 4:00pm.** You are invited to spend time in prayer during these hours before the rose makes its way to Mexico and the altar of Our Lady of Guadalupe.

**Confirmation:** Confirmation is one of the 3 Sacraments of Initiation. Those who are eligible to be Confirmed at St. Richard must be contributing, active members of St. Richard parish (registered over 18 months) between the ages of 12 and 18. Adult Catholics seeking Confirmation are also welcome to participate. The preparation will be late winter 2023. Confirmation is set for February 5, 2023 at 5:00pm. Mass will be celebrated by Bishop Kopacz. Those from other parishes are welcome to participate in the ceremony but must do their Confirmation preparation in their home parish.
